Definitions

Alliteration rhyme – A rhyme with the repetition of sounds

Riddle – A question or statement which offers a puzzle to be solved

Acrostic poem – A poem where the first letter spells out a word

Colour poem – A poem with colours to express emotions, thoughts and feelings

Shape poem – A poem about an object which is written in the shape of the object

Alliterative list – Repetition of sounds in words, in a list

Quatrain – A poem with four lines

Performance poetry – A poem intended to be performed

Narrative with rhyme – A poem that tells a story

Question and answer poem – A poem structured as a dialogue

Monologue – A poem with features of a speech

Haiku – A poem with three lines of five, seven and five.

Tanka – A 31 syllable poem

Limerick – A poem of five lines with a rhyme scheme 'aabba'

Metaphor poem – A poem that uses metaphors to compare two things creatively

Simile poem – A poem that uses a simile to compare 2 unlike things

Cinquain – A poem of five lines

Personification poem – A poem which gives human characteristics to animals, inanimate objects or forces

Narrative/Classic - A poem with high degrees of quality and staying power

Sonnet – A poem of 14 lines

Blank verse – A poem written with regular metrical but unrhymed lines
